Spring Youth Camp 2010 Camp Rules

1. The Spring Youth Camp 2010 is for Muslim boys ages 8-14
2. All participants must submit a completed and signed release form and register with the Camp Organizers upon arrival.
3. Latest arrival is 10pm Friday unless prior arrangement and approval. No arrival in middle of camp. Any youth arriving late to the camp without prior arrangement will be turned back NO EXCEPTIONS WHATSOEVER.
4. Participants must NOT leave the campground without permission from the Camp Organizers.
5. Cell phone reception most likely will not be available at the campsite. In any case, all cell phones must be turned off during the camp. In the case of emergency, call the camp ranger at 503-873-8681.
6. All electronic devices must be turned off and locked in a safe place during the camp.
7. During the camp, the Organizers will confiscate and lock away any electronic device they see (including cell phones). The Organizers will hand the device back to its owner at the end of the camp.
8. Please keep all valuables at home. The Camp Organizers will not be responsible for any lost or stolen items.
9. Cleaning is the responsibility of all participants:
 - a. Participants must clean their area after each meal
 - b. Participants must keep their sleeping area clean and neat
10. Participants must observe quiet time during designated sleep time
11. For the safety of the participants and the success of the program, participants must abide by the program's rules and must follow the Organizers' instructions at all times.
12. For the safety of the participants and the success of the program, the Organizers will show little tolerance towards disruptive and irresponsible behavior. The Organizers will not hesitate to send any uncooperative participant home.
13. Parents are encouraged to visit the camp and spend sometime with their campers. During the camp, Parents are advised to allow for the organizers of the camp full supervision of the participating youth.
